- The Chinese salon is decorated with monkey scenes that have become extremely rare.

Built in the early-18th century for one of Louis XIV's financiers, the Château of Champs was a source of great pride and joy to its occupants during the Age of Enlightenment, including the Dukes of La Vallière and the Marquise de Pompadour, both prominent members of Louis XV's inner circle.

During the Belle Époque, the estate was purchased by financier Louis Cahen d'Anvers, who, as a lover of the French style, gave it a new lease of life and restored the château to its former glory.
